Daily Readings / Review

Monday – Boldness

Reading

Psalm 71:12-24

Growth Step

(12-13, 24b) How can help us overcome our fear of what others can do to us; how can He free our tongues for His glory?

How do you praise God before others?

Reflection: What percentage of your speech reflects God and His truth to others?

Tuesday – Boldness

Reading

I John 3:11; Psa 40:9-10; 119:46; Lk 9:26; II Tim 1:12; Rom 1:16

Growth Step

Pray that God will put boldness in your heart to stand for Him and to verbalize His truth to others. Identify how you can take this step with 1 or 2 specific individuals.

Wednesday – Our Life’s Testimony

Reading

Ephesians 2:1-2; 4:17; 5:8; 2:10; 5:15; 5:2; 4:1

Growth Step

How do these verses instruct us about our walk “before”, and “now in”, Christ? What obligations do they put upon us?

Thursday – Battle for Integrity in our Passion

Reading

Prov 16:25; Isa 5:20; Jn 3:19-20; Prov 30:12; Jer 6:16; Eph 4:18; Rev 3:19

Growth Step

These verses reveal the heart condition of a culture even today. Let this go deep into your prayers for the lost, for there is indeed a spiritual battle going on. Pray now for those who need Christ!

Friday – Battle for Integrity in the Message of our Life

Reading

I Cor 10:12; II Cor 13:5; Rom 7:15,24-8:2; James 1:15-17; I Cor 3:18

Growth Step

Only a few of the many verses describing the battles we face as we try to walk pleasing to God. Simply reflect upon those area where you need God’s help the most, and ask Him to help you?

Saturday – Our Commitment

Reading

I John 1:7; Psalm 1:1-3; Psa 51:1-4,7-12,15-17

Growth Step

Always make this your commitment, to seek the fellowship with God that comes from being right with Him, in heart and obedience.

Sunday

Reading

I John 1:6,8,10

Growth Step

These verses will challenge “what you say”. Does it match up with how you “live”? Pray for a consistent walk and witness. Pray for God’s enabling power.

What would you share with others regarding what God has taught you from these verses in I John?
